Jackrabbit Softball camps and clinics are open to any and all entrants (Limited only by number, age, grade level and or/gender)

DISCOUNTS

If a camper signs up for three camps, they will receive a \$25 discount off the total bill.

LOCATION

Camp will be held at the South Dakota State University Intramural Building located in the heart of campus, directions will be sent with confirmation

WHAT TO BRING

Depending on what camp is attended, campers need to bring their own helmet, bat, glove, catcher's gear, and appropriate attire. **All campers should bring their own glove!** Those attending pitching sessions need to bring their own catcher. This can be a parent. Participants should also bring their own water bottles.

INSTRUCTORS AND SPACE

Space is limited to the first 40 applicants, so you'll need to register as quickly as possible. The instructors include Head Coach Joanna, Lane, Graduate assistants Tracie Adix and Haley Long, Volunteer Assistant Chad Kulpa, and the current SDSU softball team. We will also have a certified Athletic Trainer on hand for all sessions to provide medical attention if needed.
